ROYAL PROCLAMATION FOR DISSOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT AND ELECTION, MAY 2018

On advice of the Prime Minister Rt. Hon. graystripe, the King has dissolved the Eleventh (11th) Parliament of Palmshire.

His Majesty's Government has issued a writ for the general election to take place across the Kingdom of Palmshire for the House of Commons from 2 May through 9 May.

The Twelfth (12) Parliament is summoned to meet on seventh day of November.

Candidates

To declare one's candidacy for one of the following seats, a person must meet the following conditions:

- Is one of the following:
 - Holder of a citizenship granted by the Home Office.
 - A landowner within Palmshire territories in either Virtual Paradise or Active Worlds.
- Is not a member of the House of Lords.
- Is a citizen of Virtual Paradise.

Voters

To be an eligible voter in a parliamentary constituency, one must own a property in the area represented by that constituency.

Timetable

- 1 May Dissolution of the Eleventh (11th) Parliament
- 2 May Polling begins
- 9 May Polling ends
- 11 May Twelfth (12th) Parliament summoned for Speech from the Throne
- 18 May Twelfth (12th) Parliament begins regular sitting

Parliamentary Constituencies

The following writs of election is hereby issued for:

- Borough of Downtown Blizzard (two seats), representing the city of same name
- Borough of New Cypress Hollow (two seats), representing the city of same name
- **County of Blizzardshire** (two seats), representing the said county covering rest of the Blizzard world where Palmshire has official jurisdiction over.
